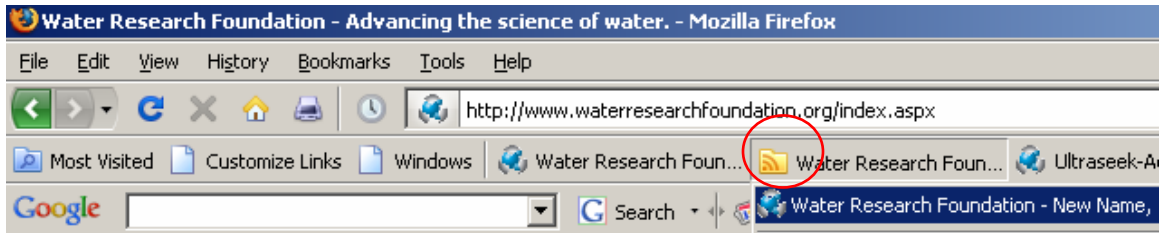


Firefox browser and Foundation RSS feed as a “live bookmark”

Why you’d want to do this:

With Live Bookmarks you can see the item titles of an RSS web feed (“headlines”) in your bookmarks. It is an easy way to keep up with your favorite sites and provides quick access to the headline items without having to receive e-mail or remembering to check a Web site.

This illustrates what the Live Bookmark looks like on the navigation toolbar in the FireFox browser. Notice that one headline item is easily accessible from the bookmark.



How to do it:

When you visit a site and you see the orange icon in the bottom right corner of the Firefox browser window (aka status bar), or if you are using version 1.5 or newer, in the right most corner of the address bar, you can add the feed by clicking the orange icon and subscribing to the feed.

Step-by-Step: Adding the Foundation feed as a Live Bookmark

- 1) Open your Firefox browser and go to our What’s New page
- 2) Click the orange icon in the url address bar



- 3) Click “Subscribe Now” and the “Add Live Bookmark” dialog box will open. Select “Bookmarks Toolbar” from Create In and click Add. That’s it!
